

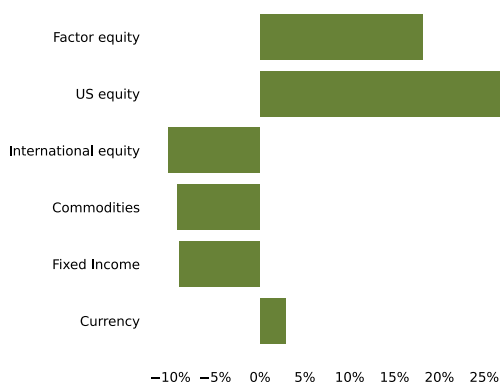

Total return, monthly since inception (%)

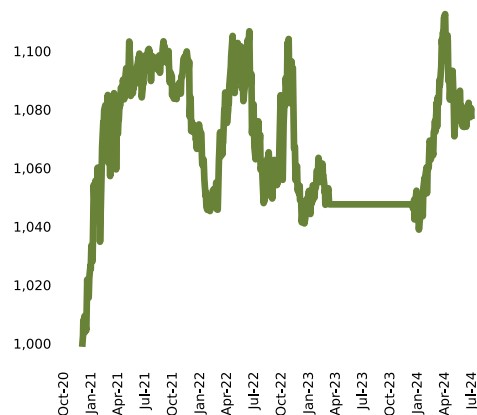

June saw further mixed messages from markets and resulted in a flat performance. Positive contributions primarily came from equities, specifically from domestic US positions, though international exposure generated some offsetting losses. Commodities and Fixed Income were the main areas detracting, mostly in longer-dated US bonds and agriculturals, with gold also giving back some gains.
