

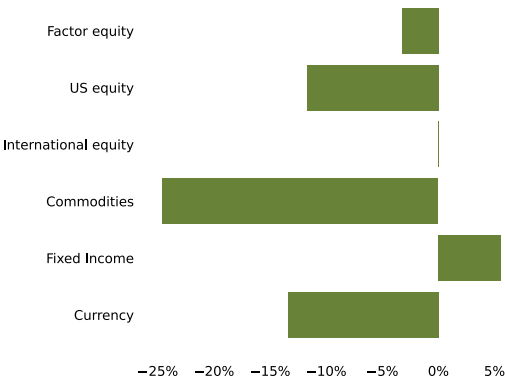

Total return, monthly since inception (%)

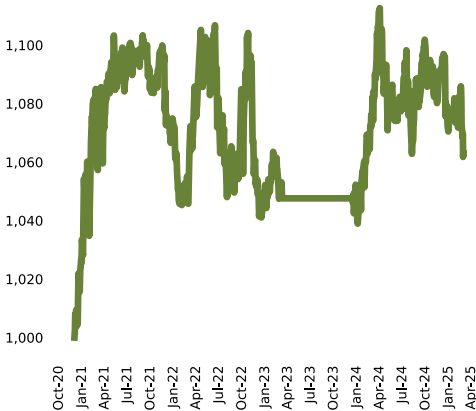

A mix of economic and political bad news hit markets around mid-month, changing the outlook for many assets. This led to a sharp reversal for our large long position in agriculturals, alongside further losses from US equities, oil and crypto. Our shorts in Asian equities and US Treasuries unfortunately provided no offset; however we did benefit from our scaled-up long exposures to credit, nat gas and gold. So far our model has opted to de-lever overall, more than re-orient the portfolio.
