

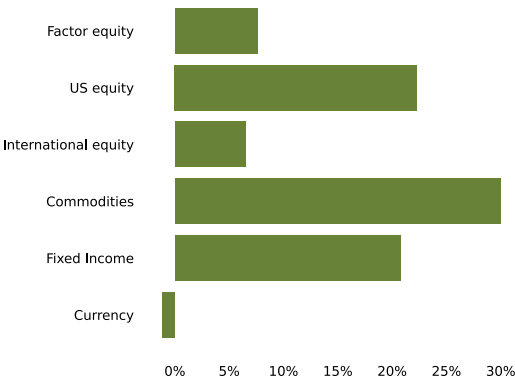
The EZ-A strategy deploys a unified, cross-asset quantitative model derived from established academic research. The strategy seeks to provide an attractive absolute return with no use of leverage and a relatively low targeted level of volatility.

A relatively strong month for assets and our models successfully captured many of the moves. Commodities led the way, largely thanks to a rapidly increased exposure to agriculturals and our long-standing position in gold. We also benefitted from long positions in US equities - both large and small cap - as well as credit. The main negative came from crypto as it gave back some of the recent gains; long-dated bonds also detracted mildly.
